



How to connect the ACPWo?

The ACPWo is a keyboard & mouse combo that doesn't need cables to work, thanks to a wireless USB receiver located in the bottom of the mouse. To use the ACPWo, follow these steps:

- 1. Locate the wireless USB receiver in the bottom part of the mouse, removing the battery cover.
- 2. Connect it to the USB port of your PC.
- 3. Insert 1 x AA battery in the keyboard and 2 x AAA batteries in the mouse.
- 4. The LED indicator of the keyboard will blink with a red light during a few seconds. It will stay turned on to indicate a correct connection.

If the LED lights during a few seconds but it suddenly fades, it means that the connection has failed. If this happens, follow these steps:

- 1. Connect the wireless USB receiver to another USB port. It is highly recommendable to use the USB ports on the back of your PC.
- 2. Remove and insert the batteries again in your keyboard and mouse.
- 3. Try to press the buttons of the mouse in order to connect with the device.

User recommendations

- If the mouse is not used in a few minutes it will enter in standby. Press any button to reactive it.
- If the keyboard is not used in a few minutes, it will enter in standby. Press any key to reactive it.
- The red light indicates that the NUM LOCK is activated/deactivated on Windows.
- If you notice that your keyboard starts having performance after working correctly before it means that the battery is close to be depleted. Remember to switch the battery when needed so it works correctly.
